RESOLVED AB02/26

That the Academic Board approves:

1. That all General Education courses with:
 - i. Enrolments of less than 25;
 - ii. Declining enrolments of over 50% for the last three years and/or
 - iii. Courses that have not been offered over the last 3 years,be considered by Faculties for withdrawal from the General Education program, with Faculties being requested to report back to the General Education Committee in time for the meeting of 3 October 2002;

2.
 - i. That at a University level, some specified amount be allocated to enhance the overall General Education Program through the Office of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Education).
 - ii. On funds coming in on a load taught basis, that Deans should have an explicit policy as to how these funds are expended on General Education.
 - iii. On funds coming in on a load generated basis, Deans should put funds into the development of the Generation Education Program within their Faculty, through
 - courses taught
 - 56 hours of professional ethics and social responsibility.
