

COUNCIL RESOLUTION CL97/054
(21 July 1997)

That Council approve revised Guidelines for the Use of the Miscellaneous Student Activities Fee, as follows:

1. The proceeds of the Miscellaneous Student Activities Fee ('MSAF funds') are to be used for the benefit of students and, except as shown below in clauses 4 and 6, only for expenditure on capital works and capital projects.
2. MSAF funds are not to be allocated to support educational needs of students that should properly be met by the University.
3. MSAF funds should be used predominantly for capital works, which they may fund in their entirety or in conjunction with other capital projects funded through the University. In this context, the expenditure may cover planning, acquisitions, development, construction, renovation, and rehabilitation of assets.
4. MSAF funds may be used for expenditure on capital equipment and on installations and infrastructure services which are capital in nature, and for recurrent expenditure on their maintenance where this is a concomitant of operation.
5. Applications for MSAF funding for proposed capital works or projects must indicate how they are to be managed and maintained, and how operating and maintenance costs will be met.
6. Personal accident insurance cover for students may be paid from MSAF funds.
